Dear Resident,

San Juan Island Park & Recreation District (Island Rec) has requested an amendment to their current Operations & Maintenance Agreement for John O. Linde Community Park to allow limited amplified sound during sanctioned events.

The Town Council has scheduled a public meeting to consider the request. The public meeting will be held at 12:00 p.m. on September 20, 2018 in the Town Council Chambers located at 60 Second Street.

Island Rec has requested that the following regulations be added to the Operations & Maintenance Agreement:

“6. MISCELLANEOUS

(e) Amplified sound can be used under the following conditions:

- Sound at events will only be allowed between the hours of 10 a.m. – 6 p.m., and not for any longer duration than 15 minutes per event.
- Island Rec shall purchase speakers and sets maximum volume level allowed for fields, in accordance with the good neighbor policy, all events wanting sound must use Island Rec supplied equipment.
- Island Rec reserves the right to approve or deny sound with any event.
- Island Rec reserves the right to deny any future requests for sound if rules are not followed.
- Sound will only be allowed at sanctioned events (i.e. games) and not practices.
- These conditions shall be reviewed once a year by the Town of Friday Harbor for compliance. Termination due to violation of these conditions can be given on 3 days’ notice.”
