**ADDENDUM NO. 1 (10 pages total incl. attachments)

TO ALL PLANHOLDERS AND/OR PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:

The following changes, additions, and/or deletions are hereby made part of the Contract Documents for the Sewer Outfall Replacement Project located in Friday Harbor, Washington as fully and completely as if the same were fully set forth therein.

SECTION 00100 ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

1) ADD THE FOLLOWING:

“All work performed on this project will be subject to the higher of the prevailing state or federal wage rates.”

SECTION 00220 SCOPE OF WORK AND DESCRIPTION OF BID ITEMS

1) BID ITEM 10 – 18 INCH HDPE ON SEA BED COMPLETE, INCLUDING ANCHORS

REPLACE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

“Includes all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and install 18-inch HDPE sewer pipe and concrete anchors from the HDD exit point to the flange connection of the diffuser as shown on the Plans and in accordance with the Specifications, and shall include field measurement, shop drawings, fabrication, marine and underwater support, installation, and testing.

Includes furnishing and installing concrete anchors as indicated on the plans.

Measurement and Payment shall be by the Contract unit bid price per linear foot measured from the under water sea-bed HDD exit point to the start of the diffuser flange connection, and shall be full compensation for all material, labor and equipment necessary to perform these items of work as specified.”

2) BID ITEM 11 – DIFFUSER

REPLACE WITH THE FOLLOWING:

“Includes all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to furnish and install an 18-inch HDPE Diffuser, Flange Connection, and concrete anchors as shown on the Plans and in accordance with the Specifications, and shall include verification of existing diffuser characteristics, field measurement, shop drawings, fabrication, marine and underwater support, installation, and testing.

The diffuser shall have identical orifice number, size, location, orientation, spacing etc as the existing diffuser to be replaced. The existing diffuser may have about 10 orifices. No additional payment will be made if the actual orifice number, size, location, orientation, spacing etc is different than that shown on the plans.

Measurement and Payment shall be on a lump sum basis and shall include all labor, materials, and equipment needed to complete this item as specified.”

SECTION 00410 BID PROPOSAL

1) REPLACE ENTIRE SECTION WITH REVISED SECTION ATTACHED.

Note that the applicable effective date for State prevailing wages for this project is revised to March 3, 2021.

SECTION 00415 WAGE COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION

1) REPLACE ENTIRE SECTION WITH REVISED SECTION ATTACHED.

Note that the bid solicitation date is revised to August 26, 2021.

SECTION 01500 TEMPORARY FACILITIES

1) REPLACE PART 1.03.B.5 WITH THE FOLLOWING:

“5. The fire hydrant at the intersection of McDonald St and Tucker Ave is available for optional Contractor use, and is generally capable of providing up to 1,400 GPM at about 75 psi, depending on time of day. See Appendices for Hydrant Water Meter Rental Agreement.”

SECTION 02515 HDPE PIPE

1) REPLACE PART 2.02.B FITTINGS WITH THE FOLLOWING:

“FITTINGS

HDPE fittings shall be standard commercial products manufactured by injection molding or by extrusion and machining, or shall be fabricated from PE pipe conforming to this specification. The fittings shall be fully pressure rated by the manufacturer to provide a working pressure equal to the pipe. All fittings shall be compatible with the HDPE pipe material. All fittings shall be of the same material and furnished by a single manufacturer.

Flanged Connections

Flanged joints shall consist of a butt welded polyethylene stub end of the same SDR and pressure rating as the pipe to be joined to and Type 904L stainless steel backing ring(s) conforming to UNS N08904. Unless indicated otherwise, all bolts, studs, and nuts shall be Type 904L stainless steel conforming to ASTM F593 and F594. Bolts shall be furnished with semi-finished regular hexagon heads and nuts. Unless indicated otherwise, threads shall be Class 2 fit as specified in ANSI Standard B1.1. Unless indicated otherwise, washers shall be Type 904L stainless steel. All flange components shall be Type 904L stainless steel or as called out in the Drawings.

All finished surfaces of the stainless steel backing ring that will contact the HDPE shall be manufactured by a machining process and shall be smooth and free of sharp edges.”

Service Rates and Fees

The following are associated costs for purchasing water through a hydrant rental agreement, as defined in the Friday Harbor Municipal code. Rates are *subject to change* at the discretion of the Friday Harbor Council Members.

Water Usage fees are based on the gallons of water that run through the meter.

Reading fees are charged for each read taken on the hydrant meter. This may include installation, monthly reads, and final reads.

Current rates for January 2021 thru December 2021 are \$16.00 per 1,000 gallons and \$47.25 per reading fee.

Terms of Service

Hydrant Water Meters will be installed by the Water Department. Readings will occur on a monthly basis for billing purposes and to ensure the efficiency of the installed hydrant water meter. Any questions relating to the hydrant water meter should be directed to the Public Works office at (360) 378-2154 or the Finance department at (360) 378-2810.

Compensation and Method of Payment

All installation locations will be invoiced monthly based on the services rendered. Payment is due upon receipt. Check remittance should be mailed to PO Box 219, Friday Harbor, WA 98250. Alternately, cash or check is accepted in the Finance office located at 60 Second St, Friday Harbor, WA 98250.
