Vegetation Responsibilities

The Town of Friday Harbor Municipal Code Chapter 9.14 defines nuisances and the duty of homeowner's responsibility to maintain their property within Town limits. Below are some reminders of how you can help our community avoid serious fire dangers by taking care of vegetation.

Grass & Weeds

Did you know that grass or weeds more than 10 inches high is considered a noxious vegetation? Please cut your tall grass and weeds as soon as possible to avoid it from getting as long as the grass pictured to the left.

Trees

Limbs cannot hang less than 8 feet above a public walkway or sidewalk or less than 14 feet above a public street. Please trim your limbs to keep these areas clear.

Vegetation

Any bushes, vines, plants, etc. can be considered a noxious vegetation if it is tall enough to impair the view of the public thoroughfare. Please keep plantings trimmed down so vehicles can see the road clearly.

Planting Strip or Parking Strip

This is the part of the right-of-way between the abutting property line and the curb or traveled portion of the street, exclusive of any sidewalk. Property owners must maintain these areas.

Outdoor Burning

Regulations do not permit any outdoor burning of yard waste material within the Town limits.
