The Town of Friday Harbor water system plan, received in this office on January 29, 2003 with revisions submitted on July 2 and September 5, 2003 has been reviewed and in accordance with the provisions of WAC 246-290-100, is hereby APPROVED.

Approval of this plan is granted through **September 8, 2009** unless the Department requests an update or plan amendment pursuant to WAC 246-290-100(9). Approval of this plan is valid as it relates to current standards outlined in WAC 246-290, revised April 2003. Future revisions in the rules may be more stringent and require facility modification or corrective action. Approval of the update of this water system plan is required on or before September 8, 2009.

This approval does not provide any guarantee and should not be considered to provide any guarantee concerning legal use of water or subsequent water rights decisions by the Department of Ecology.

This plan demonstrates how the Town of Friday Harbor water system will maintain financial viability.

Standard Construction Specifications for distribution main extensions have been approved as part of this water system plan. With this approval and consistent with WAC 246-290-125(2) the Town of Friday Harbor water system may elect to proceed with the installation of distribution main extensions provided:

That the Town of Friday Harbor water system maintains on file completed construction completion reports (a copy of which is attached) in accordance with WAC 246-290-125 (2) and WAC 246-290-120 (5) and makes it available for review upon request by the department.



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Election to proceed with installation pursuant to WAC 246-290-125 does not provide any guarantee concerning legal use of water or subsequent water rights decisions by the Department of Ecology.

The following elements have also been approved as a part of the water system plan:

A Cross Connection Control Program in accordance with WAC 246-290-490


A Watershed Control Program in accordance with WAC 246-290-135

A Water Quality Monitoring element including a Coliform Monitoring Program in accordance with WAC 246-290-300


