ACTION AND DISCUSSION ITEMS

Committee Assignments – Town, San Juan County and Community Liaison

At 12:02 p.m., Mayor Jackson invited Clerk Krembs to speak on committees. Krembs stated the committee list was outdated and requested for Council to provide an update. Council shared their seats on the following committees:

- Councilmember Starr sits on the San Juan County Law and Justice Council
- Councilmember Turnage sits on both the Friday Harbor Arts Commission and the Lodging Tax Advisory Committee
- Councilmember de Freitas sits on the Visitor's Bureau Board
- Councilmember Geffen sits on the San Juan County Board of Health
- Councilmember Hushebeck sits on both the San Juan County Solid Waste Advisory Committee and the Lodging Tax Advisory Committee. Hushebeck is an ex officio member of the San Juan County Economic Development Council (EDC) and the Chamber of Commerce

Krembs thanked Council. No further discussion.

At 12:05 p.m., Administrator Kulseth reported there was nothing new to report.

FUTURE AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

46 At 12:05 p.m., Mayor Jackson called for future agenda items. Councilmember Hushebeck requested safety at
47 crosswalks, specifically Spring Street and 2nd Street should be addressed. Administrator Kulseth shared the Town
48 does meet WSDOT standards for lighting and explained warning lights can provide a false sense of security for
49 drivers and pedestrians. For safety, Kulseth encouraged defensive and attentive driving practices and for
50 pedestrians to make themselves move visible at all times of day. The Town will continue to work with the Sheriff's
51 Office to promote safety. The Town plans to order reflective slap bands to provide to the public to assist with
52 pedestrian visibility; the bands will be made available at the public library and Post Office. Council concurred
53 reflective bands are a measure worth taking. Crosswalk safety will be a future agenda item. No further discussion.
